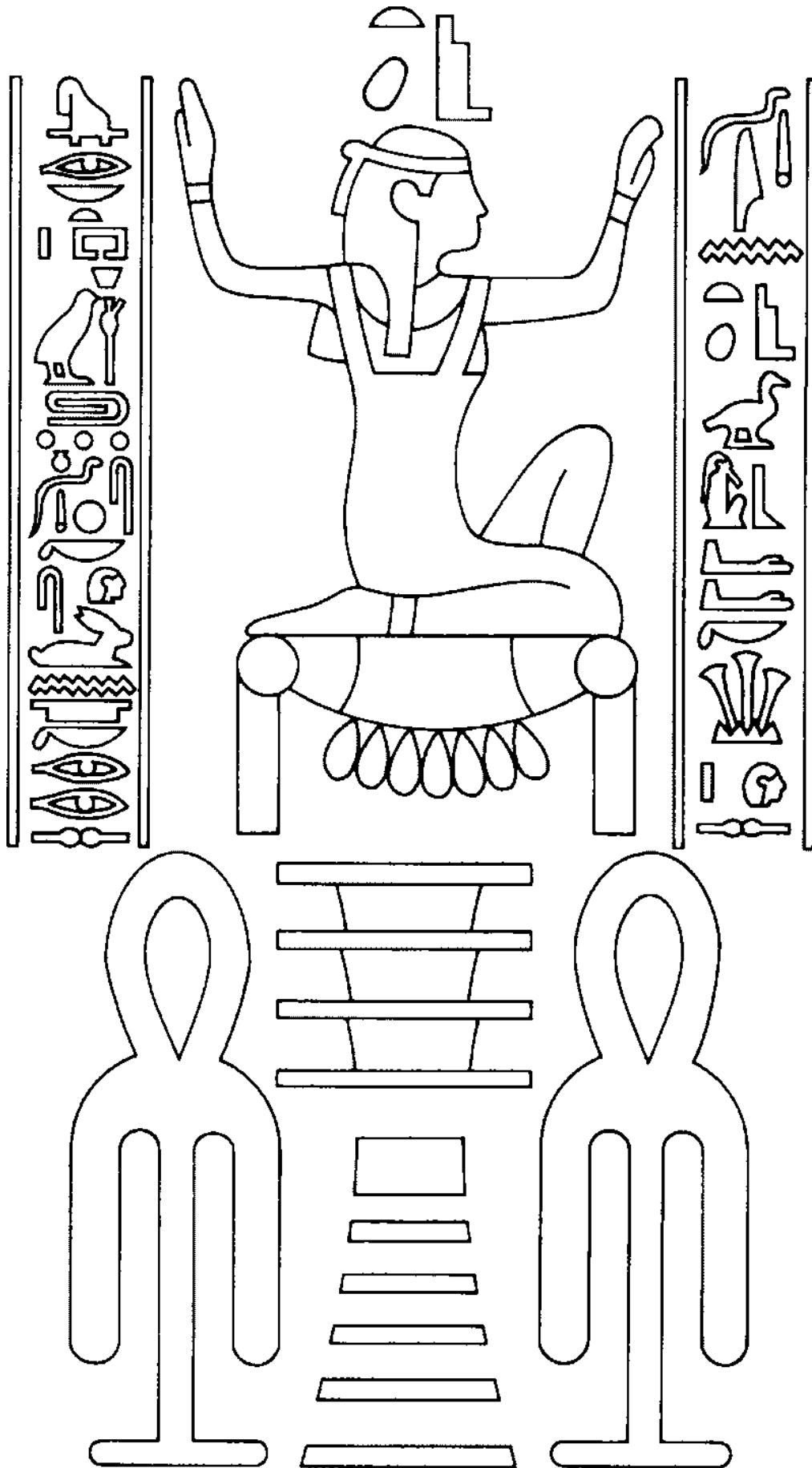
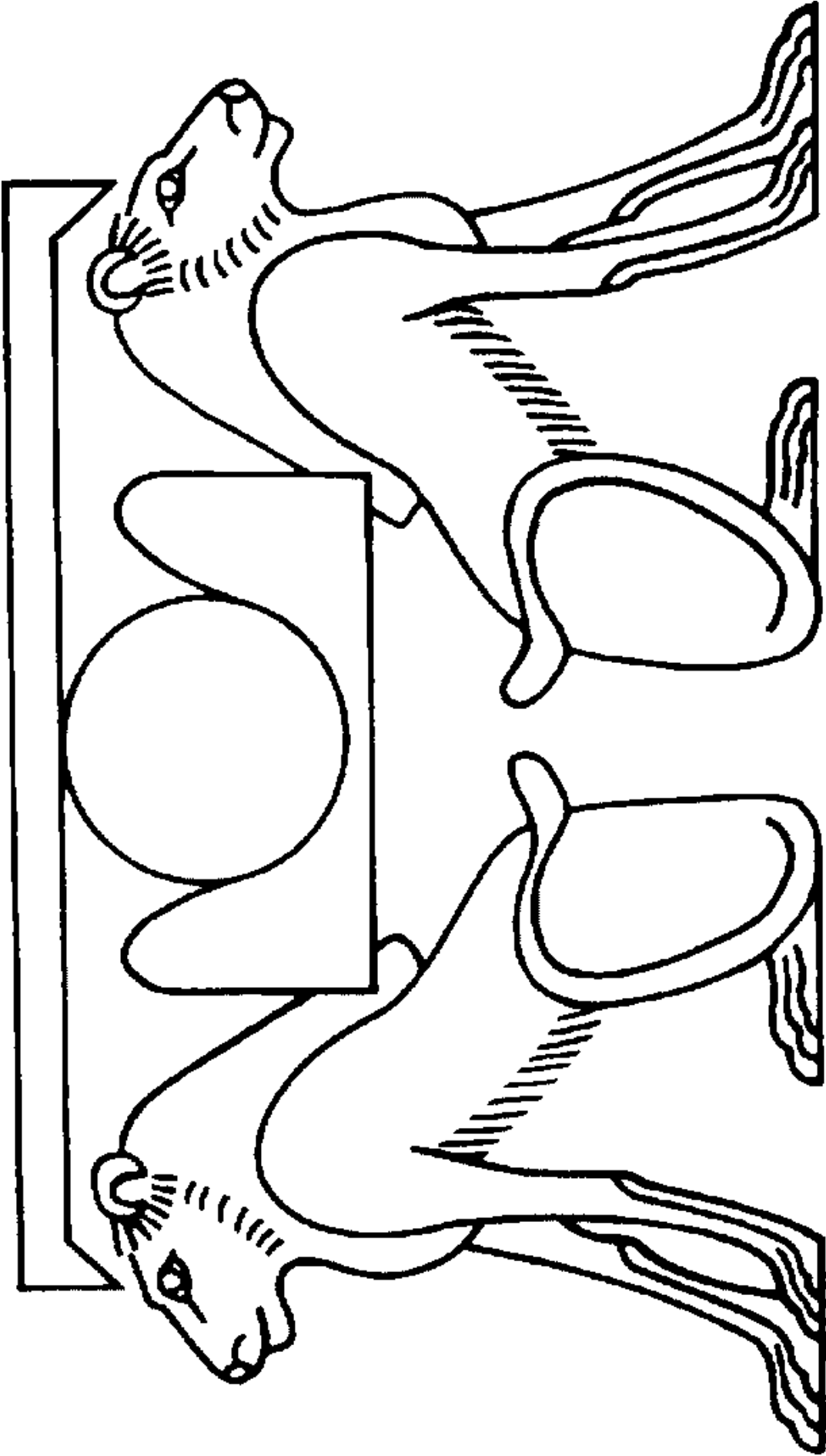


Standing colossus of Amenhotep III in the sun court of his mortuary temple

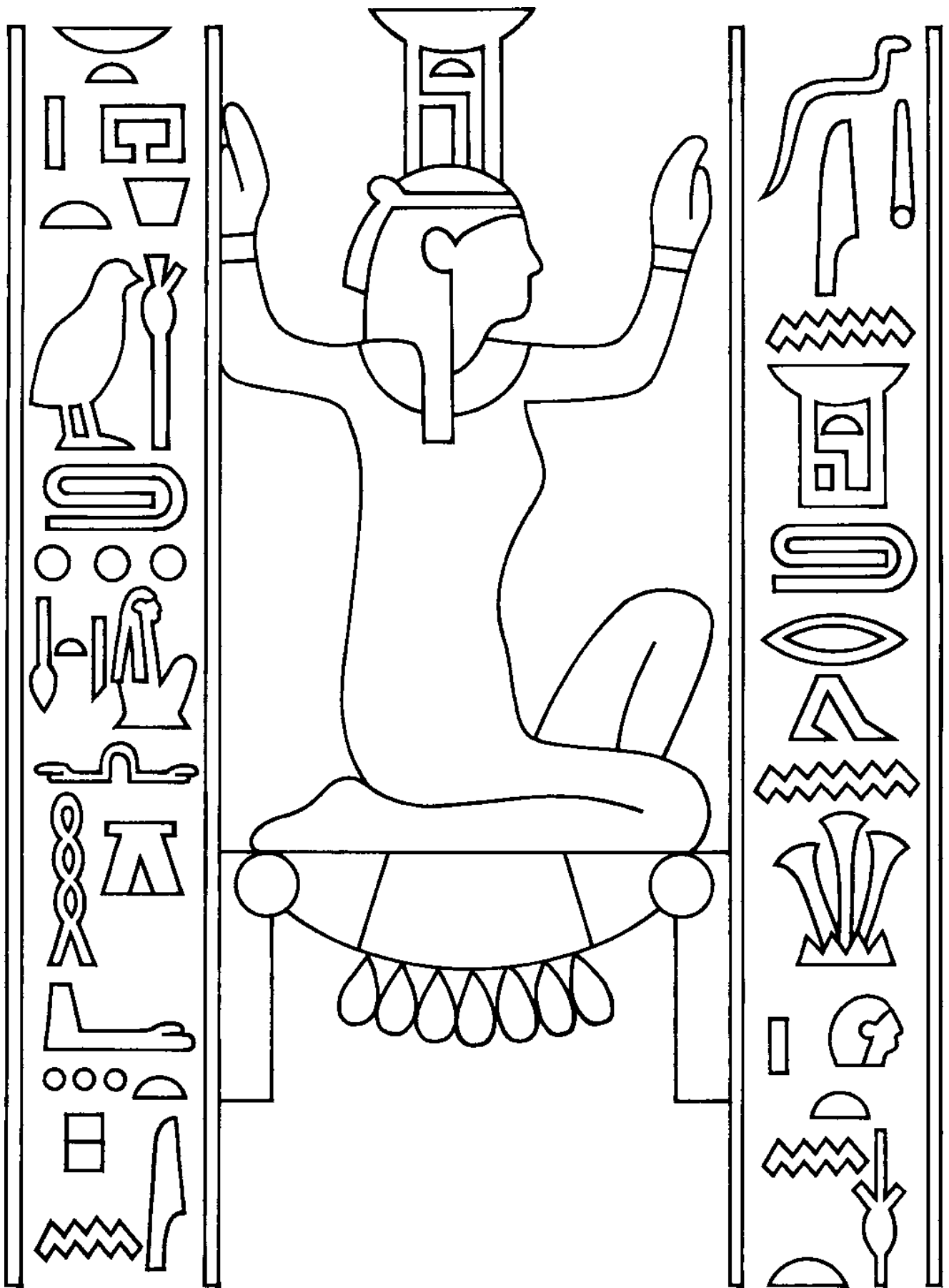

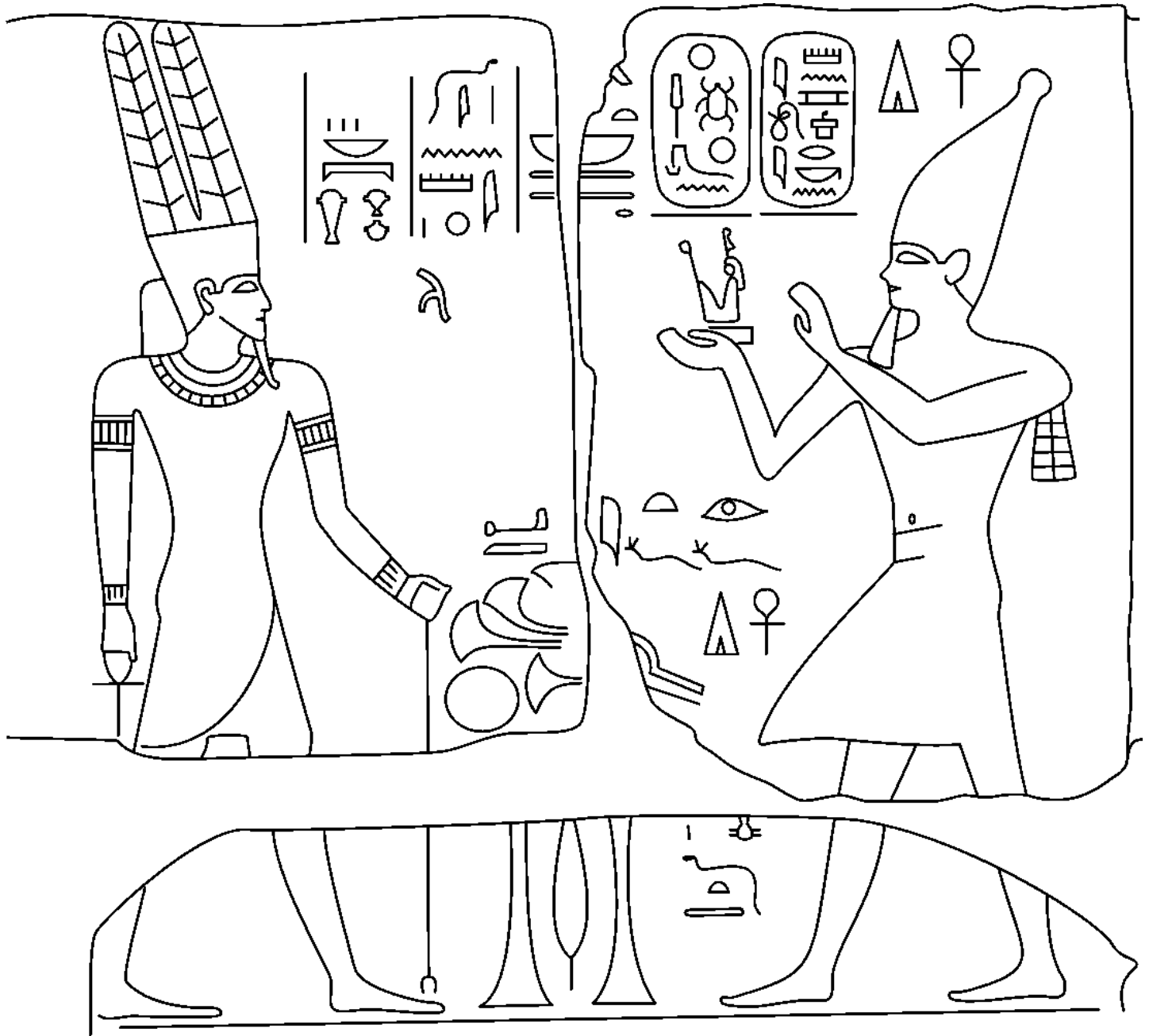


The Two Lions of the Horizon

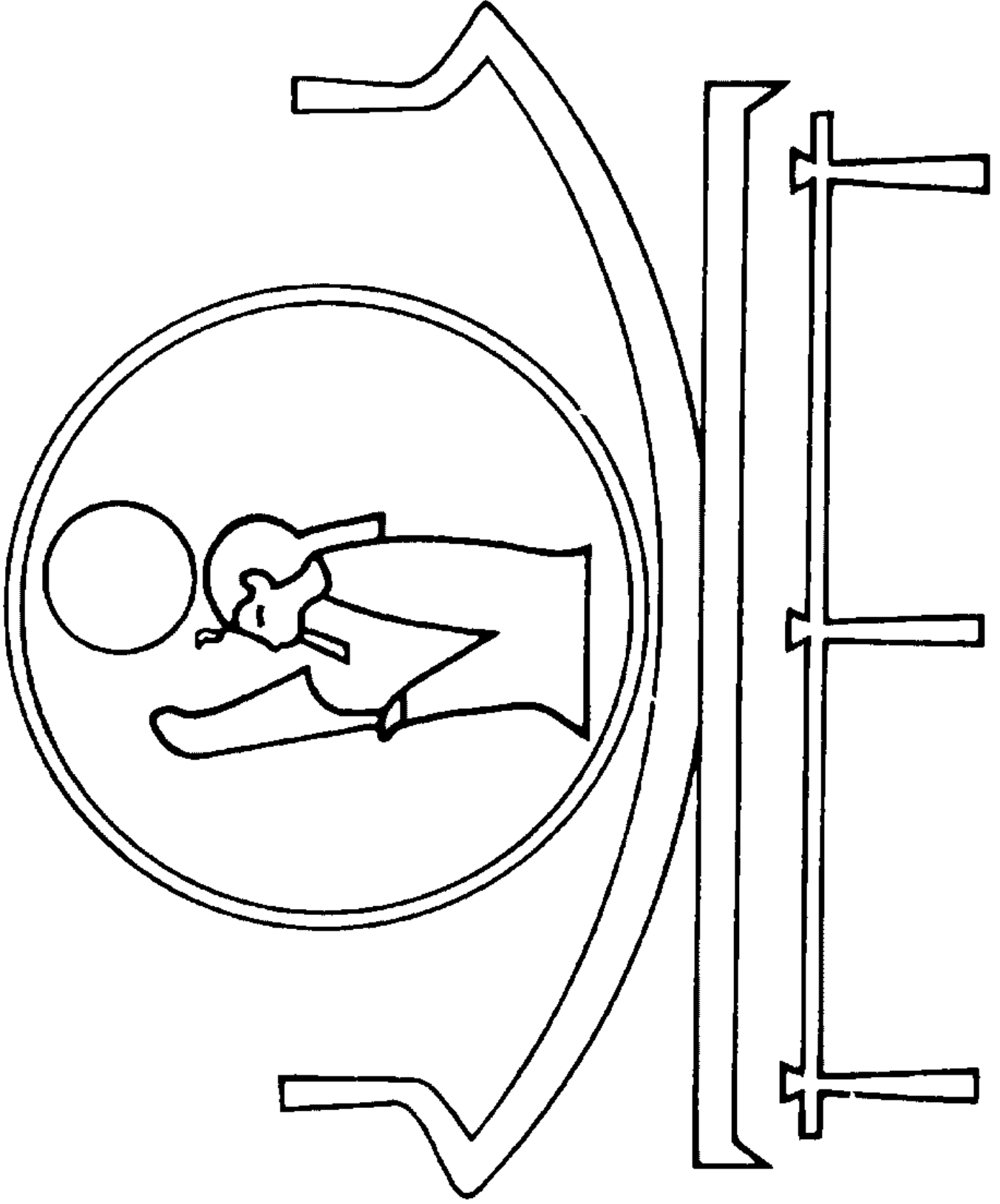

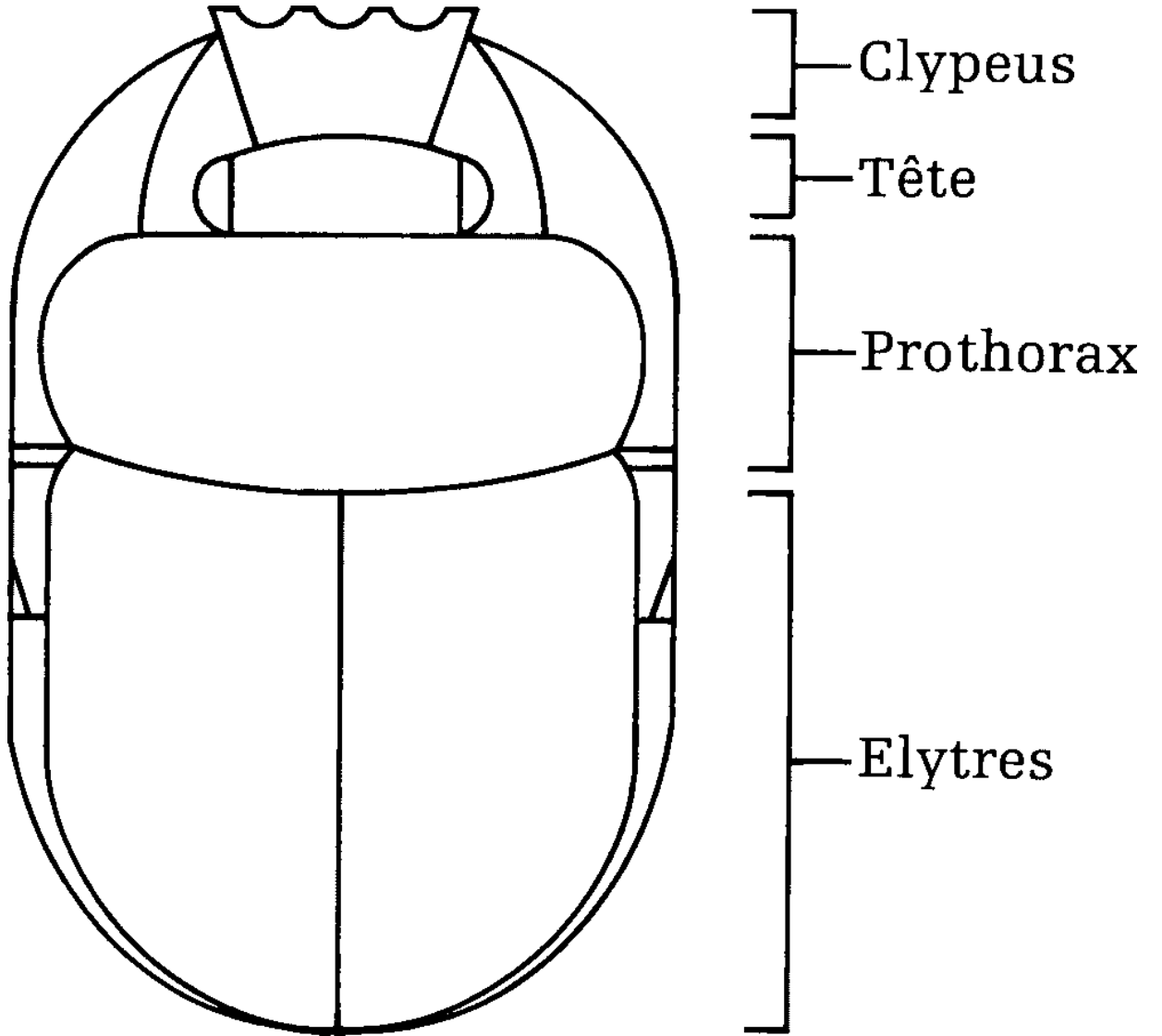

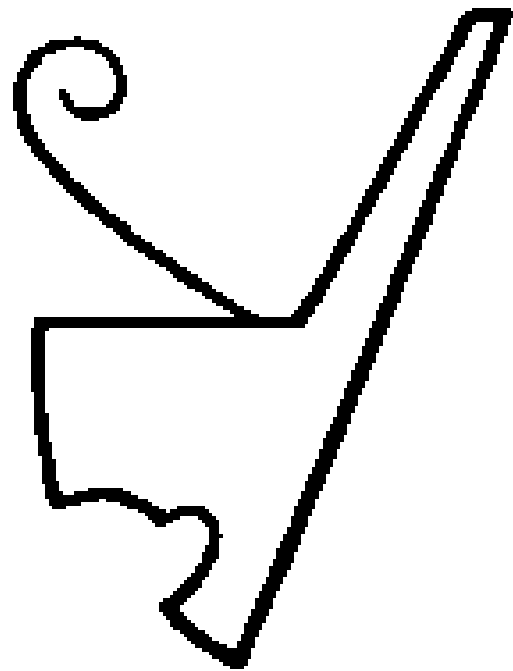
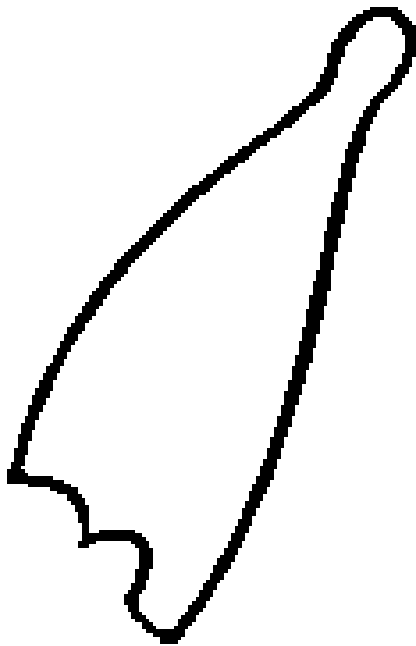
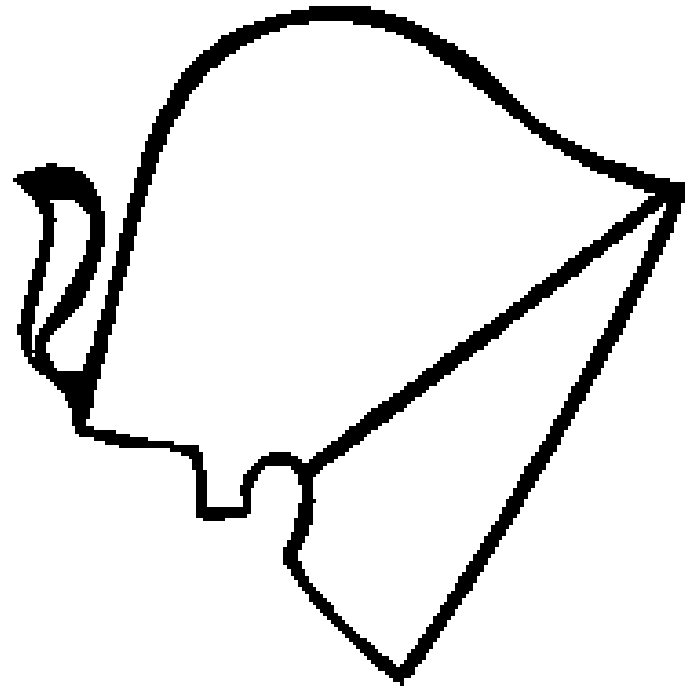
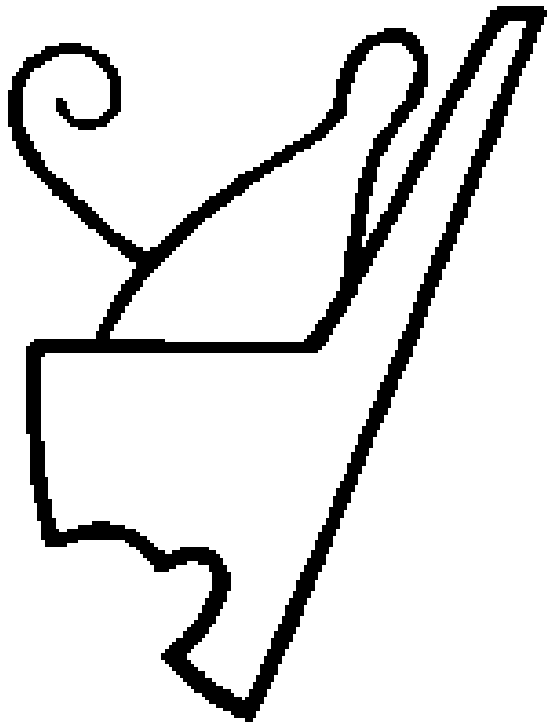
Block of Osorkon I offering a statuette to a god

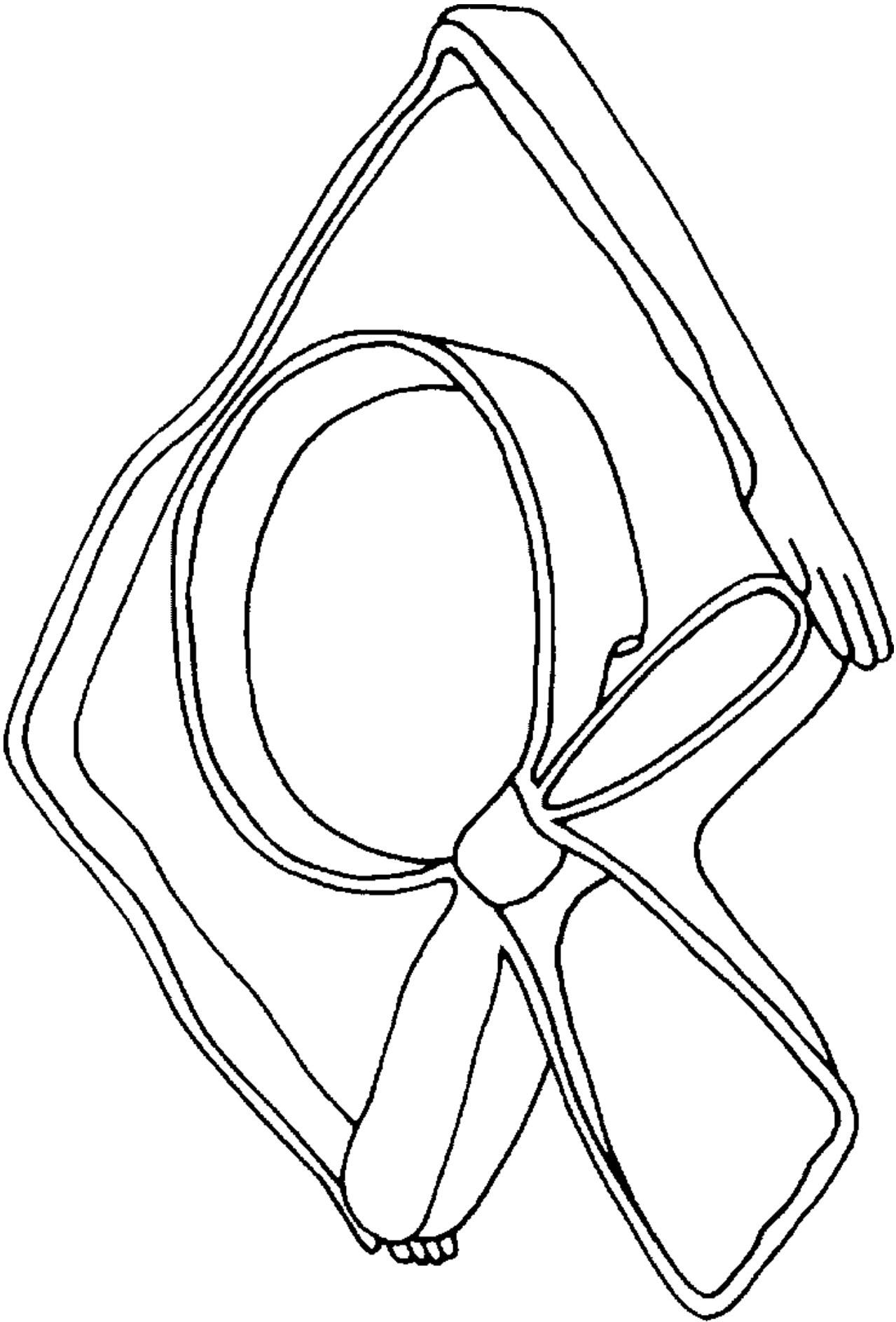
Rebus writing of "Nebmaatra is the dazzling sun disk"
